Hoosier Interfaith Power and Light (H-IPL), a faith-based, non-profit focused on creation care and climate change in Indiana, is seeking an individual to provide volunteer financial and accounting management services effective April 1, 2018.

The volunteer we are seeking, ideally, would be someone actively engaged in his/her own faith tradition who would also qualify to serve on the H-IPL Board of Directors as Treasurer.

Alternatively, the volunteer may choose not to serve on the Board of Directors but would be able to provide financial and accounting management services throughout the year.

H-IPL staff does all routine bookkeeping, accounting and payroll using Quickbooks, consistent with the Board's financial management policy. Key volunteer responsibilities would include;

- 1) Providing financial statements to the Board for review at Board of Directors meetings (currently every other month),
- 2) Selecting the appropriate financial statements, addressing grant funding and designated donations within the context of financial statements,
- 3) Assisting in constructing the annual budget,
- 4) Preparing and filing IRS Form 990, and
- 5) Offering the Board periodic financial forecasting and other strategic advice with respect to H-IPL's financial resources.
