

Solarize Evansville is holding informational sessions to help homeowners, businesses, and churches determine if solar makes financial sense for them, and to connect them with a qualified installer offering quality products at a competitive price.

Now is the best time to go solar. Solar installed by the end of this year will receive the 30% federal tax credit and the maximum benefits of net metering. Due to new Indiana legislation (SEA 309), net metering will be phased out for new solar installations:

Installation Net Metering
By the end of 2017 until 2047
2018 - 2022 until 2032
After 2022 None

Contracts must be signed by September 30, 2017 to ensure installation by the end of 2017. If you don't know what net metering is, that's ok, that's the type question we will cover at the session.

To receive the Solarize Evansville competitive rates from the selected solar installer(s), a non-binding letter of intent must be signed after attending an informational session. Bring along your latest electric bill to expedite the process.
