Dear Ms. Hazelton,

This proposal is contrary to the Hampstead Neighbourhood Plan, which passed referendum in June 2018 with 91.5% of the vote.

Erecting a number of new poles on pavements and increasing the height of a number of other poles is contrary to Hampstead Neighbourhood Plan DH1, which states: "Development proposals that fail to respect and enhance the character of the area and the way it functions will not be supported." While the placement of these new poles may have been carefully considered, they do not enhance the Plan area and are visually disruptive.

As stated in DH3, the addition of any new street furniture is to be resisted and the Plan supports efforts to reduce visual clutter by removing unnecessary street furniture.
