4. CIL update

AN: Meeting held at Hampstead Community Centre to review candidate proposals. All require further work. No further proposals will be approved until after the May elections.

JG: For Oriel PI, Wells Court donated £50k; The Heath & Hampstead Society (HHS) and Business Improvement District (BID) are opposed. The project is at a standstill. Next CIL Working Group is in two weeks.

5. Planning issues

Royal Free Hospital

DC: basement management plan passed by independent arbitrators, Camden expected to approve. RFH setting up panel to monitor basement work. HHS has a member on the panel. Hampstead Green Neighbourhood Group mulling a judicial review.

CW: Forum fully loaded with Plan work.

White Bear

The White Bear Group, which lobbied for the pub's ACV listing, has asked Camden to withdraw planning permission for joint school/pub development. School has doubled pupil numbers since 2013.

Action

7. AOB

CW: Highgate NF proposes a bus route around the Heath to reduce vehicle emissions. Dartmouth Park NF is concerned about E-W travel but does not support the bus route proposal. Better to push TfL for lower emissions than lobby for a specific solution. Perhaps possible to bring South End Gn bus stands into the debate.

Conservation Area Statement Update: no news.

DC: after adoption of the Neighbourhood Plan, HHS will monitor compliance.

LC: NF should hold quarterly meetings to review compliance.
