

Paid Facilitator Positions for IGNITE 2018-2019

IGNITE is looking for women to facilitate our high school program to young women in San Francisco.

About IGNITE

IGNITE is building a national movement to dramatically increase the pool of women who are prepared and eager to become the next generation of political leaders. As a nonpartisan 501c3, IGNITE builds political ambition in high school and college-aged young women in their own communities. We provide civic education, exposure to women in political leadership, hands on training and work opportunities, and a peer network of women who support and nurture each other's aspirations for civic and political leadership. Our vision is to build a movement of young women who are civically engaged, respond to issues in their own communities, and who ultimately pursue elective office. Who we serve

IGNITE serves young women (14-25) in their own communities. These are girls who may or may not have the confidence to run for office, but have a harder time seeking out and self-nominating for the kinds of leadership opportunities and training they need to get there.

How it works

IGNITE's high school programs are delivered to groups of 12-20 young women in schools and non-profits, and meet 90 minutes after-school, twice a week (or 3 hours weekly) over the course of the academic year. The training program includes:

- Civic education with a special focus on how government works and the intricacies of voting
- How to run for office – public speaking, fundraising
- Hot-button policy topics like immigration or parental notification, that participants can relate to and get excited about
- Policy project focused on legislative advocacy at the state level
- Local female candidates and elected officials speak to each class throughout the program and ultimately provide volunteer opportunities on their campaigns
- Access to regional conference and convening

The position

Facilitators teach for 2-3 hours a week after school – sometimes 2 days a week, sometimes one-day a week, depending on the school site. The IGNITE curriculum is 50+ hours long and is delivered over a 12-week period for two school semesters. Programs typically start in late August / early September and end May/June.

Teachers **MUST** make a year-long commitment and agree to complete the program at their site once they start.

IGNITE facilitators participate in two mandatory trainings (August 2018 & January 2019) on the principles of youth development, classroom management, and our curriculum. Facilitators are required to participate in monthly regional calls – each call lasts 45-60 minutes. IGNITE facilitators will also have bi-monthly one-on-one's with the IGNITE CA State Program Manager.

Compensation: \$3,000 stipend total for 10 months (\$300 paid in monthly installments over 10 months)
