#### Why TEAACH?

Asian Americans are one of the fastest growing populations across Illinois, nearly 800,000 people as of 2017, yet our stories in history textbooks are nowhere to be found.

This erases the legacies and contributions of Asian Americans throughout history, leading to a less complete understanding of US history as a whole.

#### **Impact**

By ensuring that Asian American history is taught in our schools, we are laying a foundation for the future. Asian American students will learn stories that reflect their experiences. All students will better understand Asian American communities, experiences, and histories.

### What does the TEAACH Act do?



- Amends the Illinois School Code to require that a unit of Asian American History is taught in all public schools.
- Pairs with the release of a five-hour PBS film series and K-12 curricula, compliant with Common Core and National Standards.
- Ensures that Asian American stories and experiences are taught, not just the stories of Asians outside the United States.
- Improves cross-cultural education and helps combat discrimination, racist stereotypes, and xenophobia.
