MOVEMENT PLAN

The forces of oppression are organized which means we must have a higher level of organization in anything we do, particularly safety

A collective (not just individual) security plan is essential

What are the necessary components of a security plan?

1. Collective efforts to look out for each other
2. Developing a check in procedure
3. Training for how to respond collectively to a crisis
4. A strike team to respond to urgent matters
5. Security language (code)
6. Identifying safe collective locations

Equipment needed, obtained, and practiced to utilize effectively



CHECK-IN PROCESSES

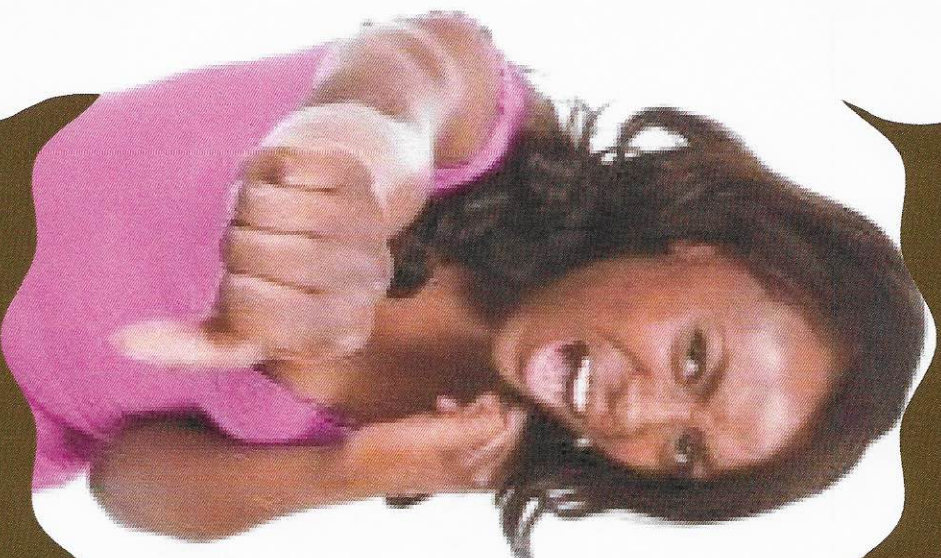
Develop mechanisms to get in touch quickly and collectively like Group me, Whatsapp, buddy systems, text loops, phone trees, etc.

Establish protocols/triggers for using your emergency communication processes

Establish language/codes that trigger your communication processes

Ensure everyone is trained in how to use your processes

Have collective practicing of scenarios

Procedure to get there safely

Process to confirm everyone's whereabouts

Establish your process for when people are in peril

Strike team prepared to respond

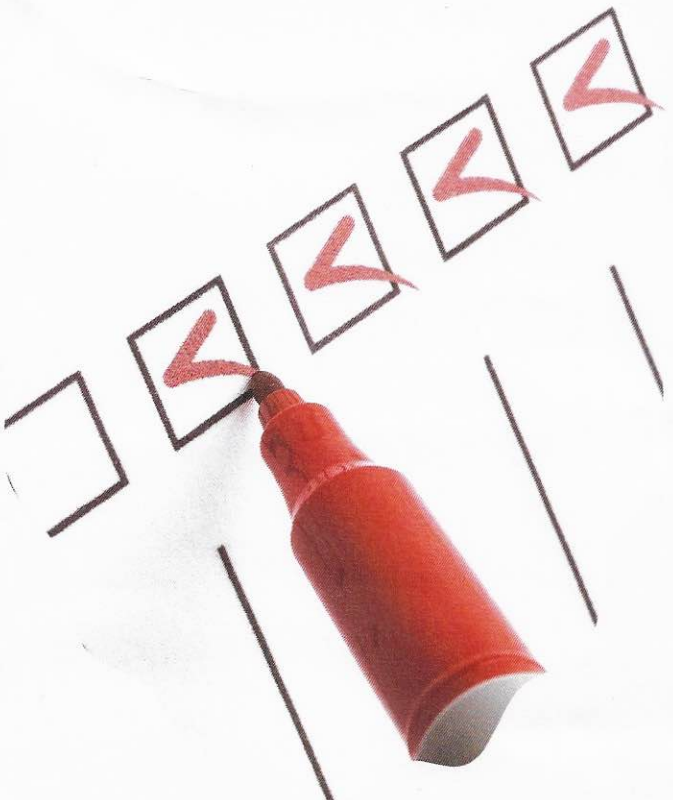
Training/practice for how to use security tools through daily safety practices:
