STUDENT GALLERY MISSION

The mission of Student Gallery exhibitions is to give students an opportunity to participate in an art exhibition in a non-competitive environment and learn how to present their artwork professionally. (For many, it is their first art exhibition.) The goal is to share with others and to learn how to display artwork in a professional manner, with assistance from the exhibitions staff.

The guidelines and information listed below were developed with the Indianapolis Art Center's mission in mind to inspire creative expression in people of all ages by providing interactive art education, outreach to underserved audiences, support of artists, and exposure to the visual arts.

Photography, Printmaking, and Digital Arts: September 9, 2020

Drawing and Mixed Media: November 18, 2020

HOW TO APPLY

Complete the attached application form. Cut on dotted lines, attach Artwork Tag to the front of Artwork and turn both the work and form in to Guest Services.

ELIGIBILITY

- Work will be accepted on a first come, first served basis until space is full.
- Works must be delivered and ready to display on or before the due date.
- Works must remain on display during the full run of the exhibition.
- Artist must be a student of the Art Center or have taken a class in the past two years
- Artwork must have been created in the past two years
- Works shown are still eligible for the **Annual Student Show**.
- When sales are made of student work currently hanging in the hallways at the Indianapolis Art Center, there will be a **35% commission** taken. Sales must be handled through either the Exhibitions Department or Guest Services (Front Desk).
- Works are displayed at the artist's own risk. Pieces are not insured individually. **Students are required to sign a "Waiver of Insurance" in order to exhibit their artwork.**
- Multiple works may be submitted.
