# OneAmerica Broad Ripple Art Fair Emerging Artist Application Form

Fair dates: May 19 and 20

Application deadline: Friday, March 30<sup>th</sup>

The Indianapolis Art Center is very excited about the 2018 annual Student Sale at the OneAmerica Broad Ripple Art Fair. Students will again participate in the sale of their own artwork among other participating professional artists. This is a great opportunity for students to build comradery among other students and artists, to sell their work, or explore making the leap into professional art making.

## Application guidelines:

- Indianapolis Art Center students who have taken at least one class or workshop since January 2015 are invited to participate in the Emerging Artist area of the OneAmerica Broad Ripple Art Fair. Students may not sell any work outlined as ineligible in the prospectus (available at [www.zapplication.org](http://www.zapplication.org) or via email by request), and they may not sell work that is packaged, licensed, or distributed for mass sale ("buy-and-sell" items).
- The Emerging Artist area will be in the Artist Field area (located on the south side of the building between 67<sup>th</sup> and 66<sup>th</sup> Street.) There will be up to seven professional grade tents 10' deep x 20' wide (provided by the Art Center). Each tent will be shared by up to four students. One six-foot table will also be provided for each student.
- There are 26 spaces available for students this year. If more than 26 applications are received, students will be selected by lottery. *Students will be notified on **Monday, April 2<sup>nd</sup>**, regarding acceptance.*
- Students will be responsible for handling their own sales and sales tax. There is No commission taken by the Art Center.
- Students are responsible for all of their own packaging, wrapping, receipts, and other materials the student deems necessary for their sales.

- Indianapolis Art Center faculty members are not eligible for participation.
- Students must be 18 or older to participate, must sign the Risk and Liability Statement (see below), and are responsible for their own insurance.
- The fee to participate (due upon acceptance) is **\$200**. Keep in mind there is **no commission taken**, so this is the only fee.
