All property owners in Prince George's County pay a Clean Water Act fee, but houses of worship can save money by attending this workshop to learn more about caring for their grounds and participating in the Alternative Compliance Program.

Your congregation can reduce its Clean Water Act fee permanently by annually:

Raising Awareness about Caring for the Earth through Outreach & Education Programs:

- Host a Raincheck Rebate Program. On site recycling & better waste management.
- Hold an on site trash pick-up event.
- Plant at least 5 trees on site.
- Provide a youth education program.

Practicing Green Housekeeping at your House of Worship:

- Conserve water & use water-saving landscaping practices.
- Establish & maintain healthy vegetative cover.
- Regularly sweep up trash & debris.
- Practice proper pollution prevention measures.
- Properly dispose of hazardous materials.
- Reduce or eliminate fertilizer & pesticide use.
- Responsibly manage common chemicals used on your property.
