3. Community Engagement & the "I am Iranian Canadian too" Campaign

Motion M-20150601-3

Motion Text:

In pursuit of its community engagement objective, and in light of the fruitful efforts of the I am Iranian Canadian too Campaign in attracting a large number of members in the past year for the organization, an item to be added to the agenda of the next meeting to have the ICC extend an invitation to the organizers of this campaign and request that they act as the community engagement arm of the ICC.

<u>Status:</u>

Motion carried unanimously.

4. Event organized by the Islamic Society of York Region

Discussion:

Arsalan Kahnemuyipour proposed that we conduct an online survey in relation to this matter.

Mitra Safari stated that while electronic surveys are a useful tool in certain circumstances, it may not be the best mechanism in this case

Behrouz Amouzgar stated that given that new board members were elected only a day before this issue was raised with the ICC, it would have been more appropriate for the old board to deal with this matter.

Soudeh Ghasemi stated that any activity that is for or against the government of Iran qualifies as partisan and hence is outside of the mandate of the ICC. A survey of the members should be conducted to determine whether the members wish to have the ICC operate in the areas of Human Rights in Iran.

Arsalan Kahnemuyipour stated that the ICC shall remain non-partisan but at the same time it shall act in the best interests of the Iranian-Canadian community. A position that has the upholding of the best interest of the Iranian-Canadian community at its core, is not necessarily partisan if it happens to favour or hurt any particular political group, party or government, so long as such position is taken with the view to uphold the best interests of the Iranian-Canadian community.

Bijan Ahmadi stated that while he is personally outraged with this event but he believes that we should consult with members before deciding the role of the ICC in this matter.

Arshak Shojaei stated that you cannot survey the obvious such as democracy or the human rights. Respect for and protection of Human Rights is essential. Mr. Shojaei suggested that the board release the statement prepared by the previous board.

Shahram Namvarazad stated that if German-Canadians celebrate Hitler, it would outrage everyone and they would certainly react.

Behrouz Amouzgar stated that in order to be able to respond to matters such as this, the board should also consider the tools provided to it in the bylaws such as cooperation with other community groups.
