And here's another hugely important announcement:

As well being a powerful campaigning tool for the final phase of Varadkar's snap election, the first issue of The Irish Patriot also announces the formation of Síol na hÉireann. I am inviting you personally to join, so it's only right that I answer the three most important questions about this exciting new Irish initiative:

What is Síol na hÉireann?

Síol na hÉireann means Tribe/Seed of Ireland. While its name and ethos are rooted in our sacred Irish soil and our ancient traditions, this is an organisation dedicated to using best 21st century campaigning practice to build a real nationalist alternative in all our 32 Counties.

Síol na hÉireann will bring a much-needed return to nationalist political a new drive for cultural and community activity but in the real world;

We will continue to use social media for as long as possible, but we recognise that it is time to find ways to end the recent over-reliance of nationalists and anti-establishment rebels on Big Tech platforms that are owned, controlled and brutally censored by liberal globalists.

Furthermore, we understand that too much focus online encourages passive, politics-as-entertainment operations to the detriment of building genuine, lasting organisational strength and personal involvement. Our aim is to build a movement of - and on - the streets, for and within our communities. We want the politics of action, not the conservatism of retreat or social media entertainment.

Is it a political party?

Yes but not registered at the moment as it will be several years before the next election, but Síol na hÉireann is far more, it is a nationalist movement. The work we are just beginning is needed, and will go ahead, totally separate from the electoral and political process. We are building an political activist movement dedicated to agitation, education and organisation every day of every year.

Rather than merely contesting elections that are automatically rigged in favour of the establishment, Síol na hÉireann will concentrate on protesting against injustices done to Irish people and on organising long-

term campaigning, cultural and counter-power resistance to the elite's plantation of our country and the replacement of our people.

Irish nationalists of all people shouldn't need to be told that groups obsessed with electioneering are putting the cart before the horse. We remember that the Gaelic League and the IRB did not come before Political Sinn Fein and political success by accident.

Real changes in political power come from political awakening, from a risen people. So, a movement that wakes and organises the people has to be created before real political change can be anything more than a pipe-dream.

We may for tactical reasons register in due course, but we would be happier to see one of the existing parties adopt a principled, radical nationalist position parallel to our own and step up to fulfil that role. Time will tell, but even if we do register and stand, the majority of Síol na hÉireann's efforts will always be towards campaigning, grass-roots community work, and providing practical support for Christianity, family values to the true Irish on this Island no matter what Christian Church they belong to.

Why now?

If left until after the election, it is likely that our initiative would be portrayed as a 'sour grapes' reaction to bad election results for the 'right'. It is time for realism as nearly ALL nationalist candidates will poll less than 1% if they are lucky. Our launch has NO impact on the 2020 election as we are not standing!

Nationalists at best might win ONE seat in this election and probably none with most candidate getting less than 0.5%, at least four years of talk and supposed 'preparation' has already ended in most voters not even having the chance to vote for a nationalist candidate even if they wanted to. Only around 50 Nationalists of ALL parties out of 160 standing so not even half the country COULD vote for a patriot if they wanted to.

Despite this depressing reality, we look around and see a ridiculous over-confidence among those few patriots who are playing the Leinster house game.

We continue to urge people to vote for nationalists and patriots, whether they be independents, or other Nationalist Party or the even more civic Irish Freedom Party. But unlike the others, we have no illusions – there is no parliamentary road to turning around the problems caused by the liberal war on Ireland and we native Irish.

So immediately after the election, while other nationalists are shell-shocked by the scale of the defeat of their inadequately resourced electoral efforts even if a seat or two is won, we will go straight into the long-term work Ireland asks of us, that is: building the, nationalist, Irish alternative campaigning machine in the name of - **Síol na hÉireann**.

Will you rally to Irelands call ?

In the name of God and of the dead generations from which she receives her old tradition of nationhood, Ireland, through us, summons her children to her flag and strikes for her freedom ---- **Come and join us and fight back effectively and build the nationalist infrastructure our people need to WIN this fight. We have but 10 years left, then it is all over and we refuse to surrender our ancient land without a fight to the death. Are YOU with us?**
