<b>Introductions</b>	
<b>Discussion of signage</b>	Betsey reviewed the discussion from previous NCPC meetings of posting signage to remind visitors not to leave valuables in their cars. She presented some draft art and the group discussed the language, design, size, materials, and the locations of the signs. They decided that an 8.5" x 11" sign made of corrugated plastic could be placed near the curb line using the "Curb Theft" design. They also decided that smaller versions of the "Hide your stuff away" sign could be printed on card stock and posted in or near businesses. The Jack London Improvement District offered to pay for and coordinate the printing and installation of the signs.
<b>Discussion of neighborhood crime</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- <b>CRO Report</b></li><li>- <b>Top 3 Priorities</b></li><li>- <b>Community Involvement</b></li></ul>	<p>Officer Gallinatti reported September's crime statistics and noted that recently the police department apprehended two individuals suspected of vandalism at 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and Martin Luther King Jr. Way. The groups thanked the officer for the clearing of the Webster Street encampment. He noted that new locked fencing is being installed. There was discussion of car theft, panhandling, graffiti, and illegal dumping.</p> <p>The group voted on these top priorities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Vandalism</li><li>- Auto-burglaries</li><li>- Illegal dumping</li></ul> <p>It was noted that if the community sees any illegal dumping they should report it to the Public Works Department through the SeeClickFix smartphone application.</p>
