    - i. ISBE funding: 7 confirmed teachers getting OG trained this summer, STEP training this year, Guided reading/LLI ordered and received, Chromebook cart/laptops ordered, not received yet.
    - ii. STEP: Teachers will receive more training the day before spring break on 4/12, 5 teachers K-2,
    - iii. Cycle 3 opened on 5/20. 15% made zero steps of growth. Not an apples-to-apples comparison from fall data. How does this compare to last year's growth? When can we
    - iv. 5E survey, participation rate much higher for teachers (74%) and students (92%). Comes out in October.
    - v. LSC Walkthrough: May 1st 12:30pm, May 2nd 8:30am. Staff on the LSC can participate in walk through as well.
    - vi. IL Science Assessment thursday 4/11, rescheduled due to internet being down

- vii. Winter MAP testing done, teachers entered MAP stretch goals, new feature
- viii. Kindergarten Registration: Kindergarten Panel happened, can we have more preschool parent information session to help prek parents with the process.
- ix. Playground update: Danny Parks new project manager, We have a project number, we might be able to move forward with phasing. Friday, 4/12 review 60% plan, begin in July. Likely means no outdoor recess in the fall. Jahn did not receive Kaboom grant. Would CPS allow corporate sponsorship? Will have May Community meeting about playground, plan a ribbon cutting to start turf renovation.
- x. Principal message will include link to My Voice, My School survey
- xi. ISBE grant extended day pay opportunities: unpacking the ISBE order, guided reading planning, stipend for teachers attending OG training
- xii. Full day PreK, will be repainted, new sink, new furniture, etc. It will not have a bathroom, it will be a Gen Ed preschool.
- xiii. Mr. Herring will host the second well-publicized CIWP update in June, possibly co-hosted with PAC.
