Fall Session 2019: Program Descriptions

Grade	Day(s)	Club
K-2	M	Drama Club - Stamos. Students will create and tell stories through acting and pantomime. Students will also play improvisation games, learning to express themselves by creating and acting out different characters.
K-2	Th	Primary Math Intervention - Grimes. Come join us for multi-sensory math. Students will practice primary concepts through games, songs, and hands on activities. We will sharpen skills in a fun setting with friends and get excited about numbers.
K-2	T	Primary Reading Intervention1 - Lewis. Students will work in small groups on reading comprehension, phonics, and fluency skills.
K-2	T, W	Primary Reading Intervention2 - Jacox. Students will work in small groups on reading comprehension, phonics, and fluency skills.
3-5	M	Dancing With Class - Brannen. This program takes students on a multi-cultural dance journey, covering dance styles from several countries and continents. Some of the dances the students get to explore are Bollywood from India, the Lamba from Senegal and the Samba from Brazil.
3-5	W	Intermediate Reading Intervention - Rosado. Let's get in some extra reading while making inferences, look for main ideas and supporting details, and learn new vocabulary!
3-5	T, Th	Girls Running Club - Rivera. Girls will experience a fun and safe place to practice and learn about a healthy lifestyle and fitness.
6-8	W	Middle School Math Intervention - Robison. Students will receive small group and individual support to develop their understanding of mathematical concepts and their exposure to the rigor that is expected of them in high school.
