

# LETTER TO MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT

## Re: WestConnex Rozelle Interchange

Dear Minister,

Our city wants and needs world class public transport, not more polluting toll roads.

Global experience of major toll road construction has demonstrated conclusively that projects like WestConnex increase air pollution, encourage more car use, fleece road users with exorbitant tolls and eventually fill the increased road capacity they create.

In addition to this, I'm concerned that your proposal to build a shallow spaghetti junction under Rozelle, Annandale, Leichhardt and Lilyfield could cause damage to properties in the area.

Along with my community, I am calling on you to:

1. Consider a new design with **deeper tunnels** to minimise the risk of unnecessary damage to properties from settlement and ground movement;
2. Ensure there is a **community representative** on all independent property assessment panels;
3. **Expand the zone of influence to 250 meters** so all properties that have the potential to be damaged are eligible for compensation;
4. Install **vibration monitoring** at homes within the zone of influence;
5. Deploy **ground movement detection technology** to assist in establishing causation where property damage occurs;
6. Install filtration systems in **toxic exhaust stacks**; and
7. Commit to fairly compensating property owners for **compulsory underground acquisitions**.
