

ORDINANCE 2020-04

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR AND HIS AGENT TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH UTILITYBILLING FOR UTILITY SOFTWARE SERVICES FOR A PERIOD OF TWO YEARS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Whereas the Village Administrator is charged to manage, conduct, and control the water works and to make such bylaws and regulations as it deems necessary for the safe, economical, and efficient management and protection of the works, plants, and public utilities; and

Whereas the Village Administrator, in consultation with the Land, Buildings & Public Works Commission, has determined the need for more efficient software support; and

Whereas, Utilitybilling offers an efficient software support system for utility management; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE VILLAGE OF JEROMESVILLE THAT -

(1) The Mayor, or his agent the Village Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Utilitybilling for a period of two years for software support;

(2) The Fiscal Officer is authorized to draw from the treasury payment for the one time setup fee in the amount of five hundred dollars (\$500); and

(3) The Fiscal Officer is authorized to draw from the treasury the monthly subscription fee for support services in the amount of one hundred and ninety-nine dollars (\$199).

(4) This ordinance shall go into effect at the earliest opportunity after its passage
