Re: Mornington Park

The City of London has received numerous requests from park neighbours to install basketball nets in Mornington Park. A multipurpose court constructed in the southeast corner of Mornington Park was originally designed to accommodate both ball hockey and basketball. Basketball nets were only to be installed if requests came from the local community.

In order to support the neighbourhood request, the City will install basketball nets in the existing multipurpose court this autumn. The attached plan shows the court location. In addition to nets, the City will also be improving connectivity between the multipurpose court and the park pathway system and the City sidewalk along Mornington Avenue.

The City of London is inviting comments and suggestions regarding the accessible design feature(s) of this project, as required by the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 2005. More specifically, we would like to consult on:

- Recreational Trails: Slope of trail, need for ramps, location ramps, need and location of rest areas, need and location of passing areas, amenities on the path.

You can forward your questions, comments and suggestions to Lisa McNiven at the Environmental and Parks Planning office by August 18, 2017.

Construction for this project is expected to start September 2017. Please note that the schedule is dependent on weather conditions.
