



Danna J. Azrieli is the Chairwoman of the largest publicly traded real estate company in Israel, the Azrieli Group (AZRG) and Co-Chair of the Azrieli Foundation in Israel.

The Azrieli Group owns builds and operates income-producing real estate assets, including shopping malls, offices, and senior housing and data centers. Currently, the Azrieli Group has over 1 million meters under development. The Azrieli Group is the owner and developer of the most iconic properties in Israel. Since Danna commenced her role as Chairwoman in 2014, the Azrieli Group has doubled its market value. Under Danna's leadership, the Azrieli Group has become synonymous with a "blue chip" company in Israel reflecting the strength and growth of the Israeli economy.
