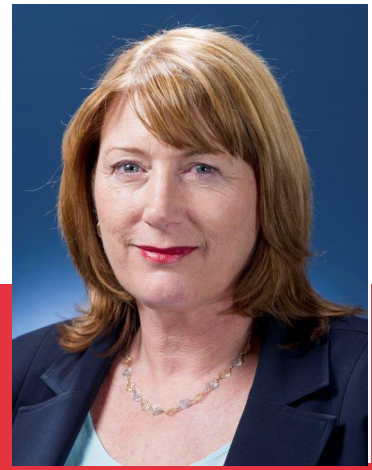

# Budget Summary

The 2016 Turnbull budget confirms the worst for people living in the electorate of Lalor.

It confirms the \$83 billion cuts to health and education that were the centrepiece of the unfair 2014 budget.

The centrepiece of the budget is possibly its most unfair measure. Turnbull's sham economic plan has two parts:

1. A tax cut for only 1 in 5 people in Lalor.

Those who will receive it are likely to receive \$6 extra a week, however, any benefits will be ripped away by the extra costs they will have to pay because of cuts to health and education.

On top of this the Turnbull Government will cut the SchoolKids Bonus and change Family Tax Benefits which will directly rip money from the pockets of local families.

For example: a couple on a single income of \$87,000 with 2 children in primary school will lose \$2350 while a millionaire will get a \$17,000 tax cut.

2. A corporate tax cut that will cost \$48 billion over the next ten years.

This clearly prioritises big business over

investing in people to build a strong economy. In fact, since the Liberals took office in 2013, the deficit has trebled to \$37 billion.

Malcolm Turnbull promised economic leadership but this is an ideological budget designed to entrench inequality and stifle the aspirations of hardworking Australians.

The difference between the parties has never been clearer.

Labor is about making sure that schools are funded adequately and intelligently - giving support where it's needed.

We'll protect Medicare and ensure your Medicare card not your bank account determines your health care.

We'll support young people that want to buy a house, by levelling the playing field and we'll make multinationals pay their fair share in tax.

I couldn't be prouder to be a part of this Shorten Labor team.
