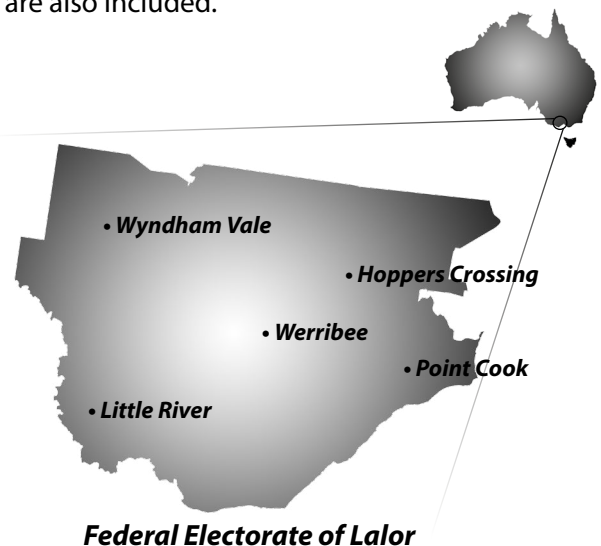
## Federal Government

The Federal Parliament makes laws for all Australians. The Federal Government is located in Canberra. There are two houses of Parliament: the House of Representatives and the Senate. All Australians vote for Members and Senators to represent them in Parliament. The Prime Minister, who is a member of the House of Representatives, is the leader of the Federal Government.



The **Federal Electorate of Lalor** includes parts of Altona Meadows and Truganina and all of Hoppers Crossing, Laverton, Laverton North, Little River, Point Cook, Seabrook, Tarneit, Werribee, Werribee South, Williams Landing and Wyndham Vale. Rural areas of Eynesbury (part), Mount Cottrell (part), Quandong, Mambourin and Cocoroc are also included.

## State Government

Each State or Territory has its own Government and Parliament. Members of the State Parliament are elected to represent each state and to make laws about state matters. The Premier is the leader of the State Government and the Chief Minister the leader of Territory Governments. In Victoria, the Lower House is called the Legislative Assembly and the Upper House is called the Legislative Council. The Federal Electorate of Lalor includes the Victorian Legislative Assembly electorate of **Tarneit**, and parts of **Altona** and **Werribee**.

**Altona District** includes Altona, Altona Meadows, Laverton, Point Cook, Seabrook and Seaholme. Parts of Altona North and Werribee.

## Local Government

Local Governments service the needs of local communities. Local councils make decisions on local, town or city matters through laws called by-laws. There are about 700 local governments in Australia. These may be known as municipalities, shires, boroughs, towns or cities depending on where you live. Councillors or Alderman are elected to represent the people who live in that community. The Mayor or Shire President leads the council or shire. The Federal Electorate of Lalor includes the Local Council of **Wyndham**, and a small part of **Hobsons Bay**.

The **Wyndham City Council** is divided into 3 wards. Chaffey Ward includes Tarneit and part of Hoppers Crossing. Harrison Ward includes Laverton North, Truganina, Point Cook and part of Hoppers Crossing. Iramoo Ward includes Wyndham Vale, Werribee, Werribee South, Eynesbury and Little River.
