 Thanked those who attended and spoke at OKCPS school board meeting. Introduced new yard signs and decals to show support for John Rex. Passed out copy of speech made at the first OKCPS school board meeting and 2014- 2015 report.

 Gave examples of miscommunications.
- * Charter schools are public schools.
- * Full inclusion school.
- * School does not kick out kids. There is a progressive plan for revoking transfers.
- * The school does not choose who they enroll. 44 schools represented. 42% students qualify for free and refused lunch. We are divers and balanced. 37% white, 28% black, 18% hispanic, 12% two or more, 2% other.
- * Expansion began with parents asking questions about middle school. John Rex and other involved charters will begin community engagement meetings. Kipp has listed meeting dates and JRCES parents are encouraged to attend.

- * There is not a list of schools that will be transformed into charter schools. There is no list.
- * John Rex will start hosting meetings. Dates will come at a future time.

Questions

What about students who are out of OKCPS district? Students who are currently enrolled will keep their spot. There is a return rate of 98%.

Umbrella? Dr. Pierce asked what would a middle school look like. Supported parents to go out to look at middle school models from around the country.

How does OKCPS cuts affect out school? State took back some allocations. There will not be much of an affect for the next school year. Will have to continue to make adjustments throughout the years. School is committed to paying teachers above the state minimum, flex benefits, health insurance and retirement.
