Road Closures

Festival Road Closures commence as of 6:00 AM on Friday, June 21. Full road closure information can be found online at pridetoronto.com/roadclosures.

Residential Building Parking Access

Laneways within road closures will be available for residents to access building parking facilities throughout the Festival Weekend. To limit laneway use from non-residents we are issuing vehicle permits for affected buildings. **Laneway permits will be issued to your Building Management and available as of Monday, June 10.**

Expected Deliveries

Business owners along Church St will have delivery access until 3:00 PM on Friday, June 21. Past 3:00 PM vehicle access will be

restricted as it becomes unsafe as we prepare the streets for pedestrians. We encourage planning accordingly and complete deliveries well in advance.

Drink and Carry Program Update

Pride Toronto will not be repeating the Drink and Carry program for the 2019 Festival.

Drinking throughout the StreetFair will be prohibited; Drinking alcohol will only be permitted in licensed areas.

StreetFair Vendor and Activation Placements

The 2019 StreetFair will be shifting the vendors and activations along Church St. towards the center traffic lanes to maximize access to the local storefronts in addition to increasing sidewalk accessibility. Festival Security

We will have private Security at all Pride Toronto Beer Gardens and along our StreetFair. Our Volunteer Public Safety Team will be onsite throughout the festival weekend wearing volunteer t-shirts and safety vests in addition to an official ID badge during their shifts. Festival Waste

Pride Toronto has contractors who will be working Festival Weekend to ensure all waste is safely removed. We are putting extra emphasis on recycling and composting this year to reduce our carbon footprint. Pride Toronto Responsibility

Pride Toronto is not accountable for all noise complaints or incidents. **Residents are encouraged to contact 311 for noise complaints and to contact the non-emergency police line (416) 808-2222 throughout the festival weekend.**

As has always been the standard practice by the municipality of Toronto; businesses will be held individually accountable for their operations and are required to abide by the laws, bylaws, and any conditions placed on them by the Toronto, and East York Community Council and/or AGCO when their liquor license, and/or patio extensions are approved. Likewise, Pride Toronto will only be held accountable for the Pride Toronto Beer Gardens and StreetFair operations. We are also required to abide by the laws, bylaws and any conditions set out in our permits for the weekend. If Toronto Police, Municipal Licensing and Standards and/or our office receive complaints and believe the conditions were not satisfactorily met, the extension/permit requests for the business/beer garden in question may not be granted in the future.
