Blackmon is well known for her compassion and commitment to those often forgotten and excluded in the halls of power. Her communal leadership and work in the aftermath of the killing of Michael Brown, Jr., in Ferguson, Mo., has gained her both national and international recognition and audiences, from the White House to the Carter Center to the Vatican. She was named 2017 Citizen the Year by The St. Louis American and as one of St. Louis' 100 most influential voices.
