## At the heart of the community in Hillmorton

Jim Ellis & Rugby Labour campaigned actively against the Warwickshire Children Centre Closures. As a Parent, he was worried about cuts. Jim attended many meetings and met with other parents campaigning across Warwickshire.

Jim met the Leader of the County Council and explained why the planned closures were a danger for young parents and children themselves. Jim organised 2000 signatures in protest and delivered them as

part of Rugby Labour's protest to cuts. Representation was taken up in Parliament.

Unfortunately, the ruling party recommended that Hillmorton's centre should close. Nationally, Rugby Labour knows the fight to protect local services is not over and Jim is a member of the parent led national campaign to keep centres open. Jim will always continue the same drive for local community issues here in Hillmorton because he lives here.

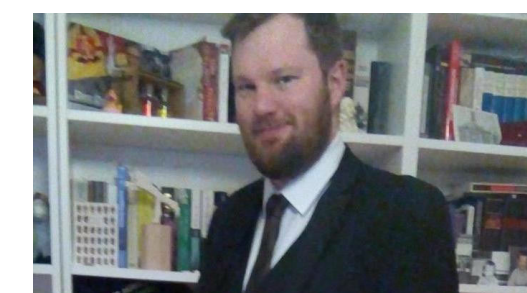
