Housing crisis: time to get tough

Rough sleeping has increased dramatically over the last five years, but it reflects the tip of an iceberg of the 'hidden homeless' in Worthing who are 'sofa-surfing' and living in cars and vans.



"I'm working closely with Labour's first Councillor for many years, Dr Becky Cooper, to tackle the problem of homelessness, by ensuring that early action is taken to prevent people losing their homes."

A decent home for all

Everyone deserves decent housing, but plenty of private rental properties in Heene - and across Worthing - fall well below an acceptable standard.

"Councils have powers to set standards and ensure they are upheld. I will put pressure on Worthing Council to make sure they use those powers, so that families aren't left living in poor conditions with little hope of escape."



Better beach access

The promenade in Heene has hardly changed in 100 years and yet the leisure needs of residents of today are very different.



"With our pebbly beach there's a need to provide better access to the beach and sea for pushchair access, for wheelchair users and for the elderly. I will press for a boardwalk to be constructed in our section of the promenade."

Richard means business

Like many residents in Heene Ward, Richard runs a small business and understands the additional pressures and demands facing those earning a living and supporting their families without the security of paid employment.



"I run a small tree surgery company and people like us, running our own businesses, are a huge part of the economy in Worthing. I will work hard to ensure we are fully represented on the Council."

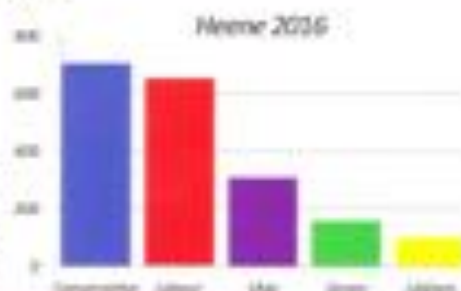
Richard's other pledges for Heene residents

- ✓ Provide better secure accommodation for the victims of domestic abuse
- ✓ Protect frontline Council services and the jobs of those providing them
- ✓ Fight for developers to meet their obligations to build affordable homes

The Labour surge is unstoppable

In the last election for Heene Ward in 2016 Labour fell just 71 votes short of beating the Tories, with Lib Dems, and Greens trailing a long way behind.

Since then support for Labour in Worthing has surged following Labour's by-election victory last August in neighbouring Marine Ward. Whatever they tell you, only Labour can beat the Tories here.
