OUR TRAFFIC PROBLEMS

Strategic plans - not piecemeal changes.

Increased traffic, particularly heavy vehicles, is a growing problem around the villages and congestion will inevitably continue unless measures are taken to encourage better public transport. STANDING UP FOR SCHOOLS

Fair funding not cuts

Despite local MP Lucy Frazer's commitment to increase funding for our local schools, they are now facing cuts to budgets. She promised 'fair funding' to match other parts of the country. Instead, our schools are under real financial pressure. As a councillor, I would champion our local schools, visit them regularly and support the great work they are doing.

HOUSING

Speculative plans - not in residents' best interests.

In Witchford 128 new homes have been approved simply because the district council failed to have an adequate plan in place. The site is too large for the village and so close to A142 it will suffer excessive noise and air pollution. The new proposal in Sutton feels like speculative developers rushing through plans that are not in the best interests of residents. We already have a deficit of infrastructure and services - this will make it worse.
