“ Policing cut: West Midlands Police Service have seen its budget cut by £126 million in the last five years, twice that of Surrey's, despite the fact that crime has risen. West Midlands Police have lost 1,500 police officers under David Cameron and crime, violent crime and sexual assaults have all increased.

Fire services slashed: In five years we have seen 30 per cent cuts to fire and rescue services in the West Midlands. We have lost 275 fire fighters. Fire stations are at breaking point, covering much larger areas than before.

A&E in crisis: Patients waiting over 4 hours to be seen in A&E is up in the West Midlands, with some hospitals failing to see as many as 20 per cent of patients in the target time. Police cars are taking people to A&E and ambulances are waiting in queues outside hospitals because they are too full to admit patients.
