RESOLUTION 21-001 DEMANDING A FORENSIC AUDIT OF THE NOVEMBER 3, 2020 ELECTION

The Lake County Republican Executive Committee, by and through its undersigned Executive Board, does hereby make the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the citizen's right to vote is fundamental to establishing representative government; 1

WHEREAS, citizens have the right to participate in elections on an equal basis with other citizens;²

WHEREAS, citizens exercising these rights are guaranteed freedom from interference and fraud;

WHEREAS, transparency and integrity of the electoral process is a necessary requirement for the formation of legitimate government;

WHEREAS, legitimate government's first duty is to guard the voting rights of its citizen electors, to ensure honest elections, and to preserve the citizen's check on their government;

WHEREAS, existing law is inadequate, and enforcement of the law is non-existent, to prevent manual and electronic interference and fraud in our elections;

WHEREAS, a majority of citizens doubt that the November 3, 2020 election was conducted openly and fairly; and

WHEREAS, a majority of citizens doubt the number of legal votes cast for each candidate equals the reported and certified results, in Lake County, the State of Florida, and the United States;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that:

- 1. The Lake County Republican Executive Committee COMMENDS Representative Anthony Sabatini's call for a full forensic audit; and CALLS on all other elected officials in Florida, at all levels of government, to do the same;
- 2. The Lake County Republican Executive Committee CALLS on all political parties, Republican, Democrat, and others, at the state and county level, to demand a full forensic audit statewide;
- 3. The Lake County Republican Executive Committee DEMANDS an immediate open, transparent and independent full forensic audit including a hand recount be conducted in Lake County, at least as thorough as the audit being conducted in Maricopa County, AZ;
- 4. The Lake County Republican Executive Committee DEMANDS the Florida Legislature conduct an open, transparent and independent full forensic audit including a hand recount statewide, at least as thorough as the audit being conducted in Maricopa County, AZ;
- 5. Further, the Lake County Republican Executive Committee CALLS for open, transparent, and independent full forensic audits including hand recounts be completed in all fifty states.

This Resolution was presented and recommended to be passed by the Executive Board at its meeting on the day of September 21, 2021 and was presented and adopted by the Lake County Republican Executive Committee at its meeting on the day of September 28, 2021.
