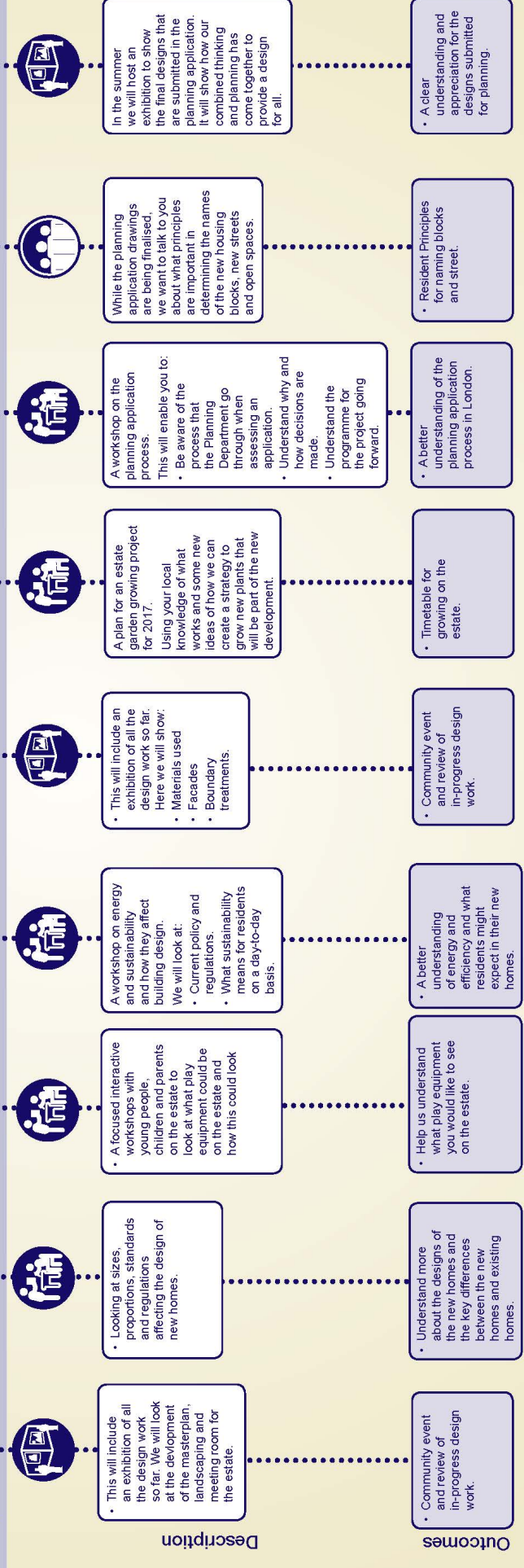


SOUTH LAMBETH ENGAGEMENT TIMELINE
