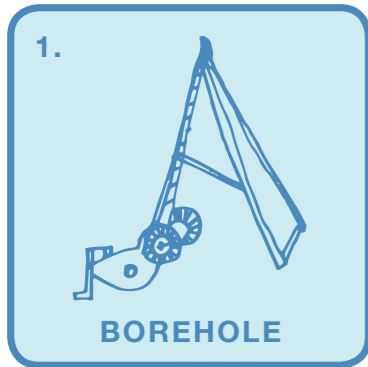


KNIGHT'S WALK SITE INVESTIGATIONS JAN/FEB 2017

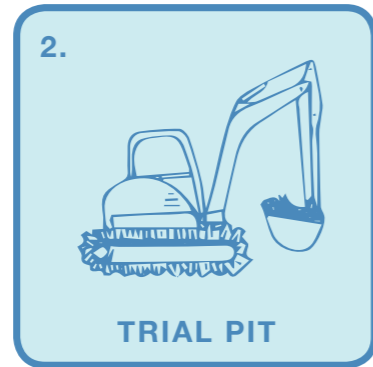
Site Investigations will be carried out on Knight's Walk in January 2017 to test the ground conditions in and around the areas where new buildings are going to be built. Some parking bays are likely to be suspended at different points because of necessary machinery access. Residents will be notified formally by Lambeth when specific dates are confirmed.

There will be three types of holes dug across the site as various samples need to be taken in order to be representative of ground conditions on the whole estate. This map shows the locations of where each hole will be.

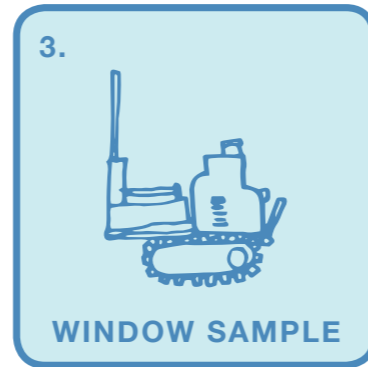
Investigations will begin after the 19th January and the full extent of the works will take 2-3 weeks

TYPES OF MACHINERY YOU WILL SEE

1. Each hole indicated on the map will be dug one at a time, will measure 25cm wide and 30m deep and will take approximately 2-3 days. The machinery used will be 7m high and will require approximately 5m square area round the hole. Some of these boreholes will involve a percussive action and others, which are closer to the underground tunnel, will involve a rotary action to reduce vibration. The noise from this digging should be less than that of a car engine

2. A small excavator machine will be used to dig a shallow pit. This should take no more than 30 minutes at each location.

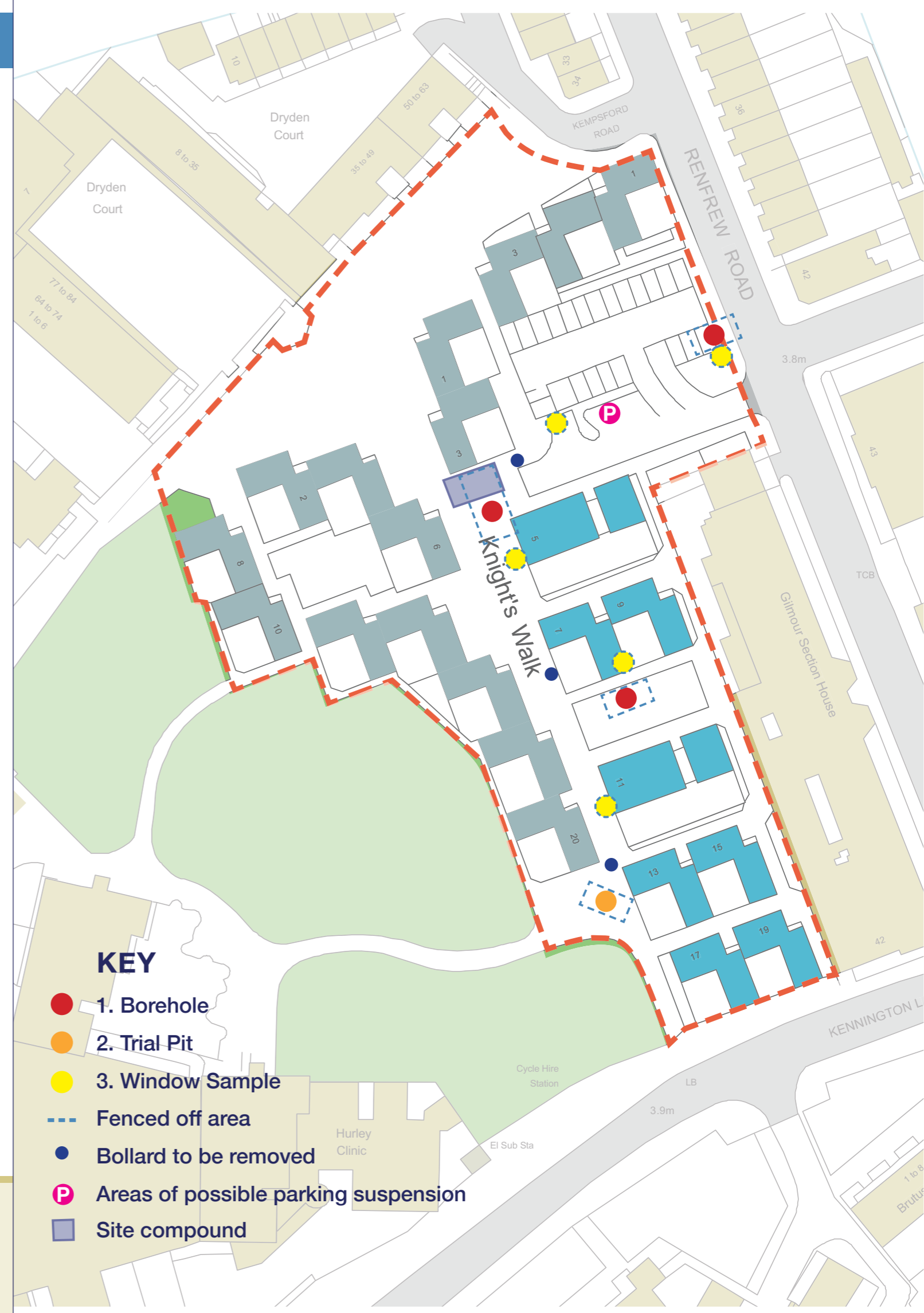
3. A window sample is a short action that would take 2-3 hours on average. This will involve a small tube being pushed into the ground.

AGREED CONTRACTOR TERMS

Any contractors carrying out works on the site will be wearing a badge. It has been agreed that the conditions around the holes will be carefully recorded before and after the works.

Once the digging is complete, a small bore hole cap will be placed and the contractors have committed to returning the paving or surfaces to the same conditions that they were found. It has been agreed that digging time will be strictly between 8am - 4pm. Each point on the map will be fenced all the way around to make sure the area around the hole is safe.
