


## TOGETHER WE'RE CHANGING THE COURSE OF THE LA RIVER

complete the path.






Thanks to a generous grant from The Walt Disney Company, we broke ground on 3 Rio Vistas Project "parklets" designed by high school students with the guidance of local landscape architects that transform derelict street ends into vibrant river access points.

In May, we synthesized everything we've learned into the **LA River Index**. For the first time, we now have a single, transparent data compilation online and accessible to the public for free.



#### A SMALL SAMPLE OF THE OPPORTUNITIES FOR TRANSFORMATION




#### **28.5 MILLION**
