LITTER & DOG WASTE ISSUES

Over the past few weeks, several Conwy residents within the Aberconwy Senedd constituency have informed me of issues that are covered by your cabinet portfolio that they are currently facing.

In response to their concerns I committed that I would raise these issues with yourself in the hope of obtaining more information on the overall direction the Council is heading down to tackling these problems, and ultimately to eliminate these concerns for the people of Conwy.

The following are a few direct comments that have been sent to me via several residents surveys:

- *"Less litter!"*
- *"Less dog poo"*
- *"A crackdown on litter on the B5106, around the lakes and where dog walkers go and leave bags of poop all over the place."*
- *"Less litter"*
- *"Weekly black bin collection and proper bins for recycling and an end to trolley boxes"*

As you can see, several concerns have been raised about the levels of litter and dog waste that are not properly disposed of. What measures has the Council put in place to monitor and tackle levels of littering and fly-tipping across the county borough? Does the Council have a strategy in dealing with litter and dog waste in public areas across the county, if so please could this strategy be shared?

With regards, to the domestic recycling provision, several other councils across the United Kingdom do have the use of larger bins for their recycling needs. These larger bins ease the effect of collection cycles on households. Has the Council explored the introduction of such provisions for its people and if so why have they not yet been implemented?
