Background Briefing

This is proposed to ensure give the Executive the ability to co-opt Members with key skills knowledge etc and, as per the Constitution itself *"... to ensure if possible that no more than two-thirds of the Executive Committee (other than under Sections 5.3 (c) - (f)), are of the same sex, and that there is fair representation of under-represented communities in the locality, taking into account race, religion, age, disability, gender or sexual orientation and that this would create a composition of the Executive that reflects the community the local Party serves."*

The default number of co-optees in the Model Local Party Constitution is 10.
