## Application Process

- ◆ Log onto [www.humbersidepolice.uk/recruitment/policeservicevolunteers](http://www.humbersidepolice.uk/recruitment/policeservicevolunteers)
- ◆ Complete online application form
- ◆ Application Form Checked
- ◆ Invited to an Informal Interview
- ◆ References obtained
- ◆ Medical Form Completed
- ◆ Force Vetting Checks

Once these processes are completed you will be contacted by your Community and Partnership Officer (Volunteer Supervisor) who will discuss your skills and interests and a suitable placement will be arranged with an induction.

(Not all applicants will be considered suitable and it is possible that an alternative volunteering provider may be suggested.)
