Patricia was first elected in 2007. She has lived in Huntingdon and then Brampton for over 30 years. She has been a District Councillor since 2007 and has been involved in many aspects of local life. Prior to her

recent retirement she was a family support worker for children's continuing care based at Hinchingsbrooke Hospital. At the District Council Patricia serves on the Health Scrutiny panel and is highly respected for her knowledgeable and probing questioning.

Patricia says:

"As a councillor I have been able to help many individuals get the services and support they badly need. Looking after people matters more to me than political labels. Having worked at the hospital, I know only too well the pressures on this area of Huntingdon. I hope to meet many of you on the doorstep in the coming weeks".

John has lived in Brampton since 1992. He was elected as a District Councillor in 2013. He is a driver for HACT, the community transport scheme. John's wife Lesley was a teaching assistant at Cromwell Primary Academy and their daughter Jessie is a former pupil of Hinchingsbrooke School. John has taken a special interest in promoting healthy lifestyles and active travel.



John says:

"I have already met several residents to talk over the parking and congestion problems in this area. Working with Tom Sanderson I am putting pressure on the County Council to create an alternative exit from the estate. In the UK, one in four children start school overweight. If we can make cycling and walking safer for everyone and especially our school children, this would encourage more people to have more active lifestyles."
