To log onto a computer in LDHQ to do some phoning you will need the following details:


- Login: **VPB**

Tips and Information

Occasionally voters will have questions about Caroline, her policies, and the Liberal Democrats. Below are some answers to questions you are likely to be asked whilst phone canvassing.

Caroline Pidgeon:

- Caroline comes from a relatively modest background, and was the first in her family to go to university.
- She is a mother who balances raising a family with her work in City Hall.
- She has unrivalled expertise in London policy issues.

Housing Plan:

- Caroline would use City Hall to build 50,000 council houses and 150,000 homes for private renters.
- This will be paid for by continuing the Olympic Precept.

Half Price Fares:

- Caroline would introduce half price fares on the London Underground before 7:30am.
- This would be paid for with the money saved by scrapping the Garden Bridge.

Wrap-Around Childcare:

- Caroline would subsidise childcare, helping to reduce the strain on working parents with young children.
- She would also launch a scheme to train more childminders in order to increase childcare places.
- This would be paid for with a 'Tourist Tax', charged on luxury hotel stays. Similar schemes are in place in New York and Paris.
