Make London a safer City for everyone



Hate crime in the capital is still a significant problem for the LGBT+ community, with Westminster, Lambeth and Southwark having the highest reported figures.

The Liberal Democrats will recruit 3,000 new police officers in London

and reverse cuts to roles dedicated to tackling hate crime.

Caroline supports calls to make PrEP available on the NHS and for more action to improve health services, including mental health service, for LGBT+ Londoners.

Tackle homelessness and build new homes



The Albert Kennedy Trust, a specialist LGBT+ homelessness charity, says that 1 in 4 of London's homeless young people identify as being LGBT+.

Caroline Pidgeon and the London Liberal Democrats have plans to tackle

London's housing crisis and tackle homelessness.

Caroline has set out costed plans to build 200,000 new homes, including 50,000 at council rents, where priority can be given to the most vulnerable young homeless people.

Protect an inclusive and diverse London



Pride is an essential cultural celebration for the LGBT+ community. Liberal Democrats will guarantee to continue funding Pride at the current level of £100,000 for the whole of the next Mayoral term. As well as encouraging further corporate sponsorship we will ensure City Hall match-funds pound for pound all additional

corporate sponsorship beyond what was secured last year up to an additional £50,000.

The Liberal Democrats believe in local communities and are supporting campaigns to protect LGBT+ venues like the Black Cap in Camden open and supported the listing of the Royal Vauxhall Tavern.
