Stations in Merton: Wimbledon, Wimbledon Park

Allowed Monday to Friday before 07:30, between 09:30 and 16:00, and after 19:00
Allowed anytime on weekends and bank holidays

Stations in Merton: Morden, South Wimbledon, Colliers Wood

Not permitted at anytime

Stations in Merton: Motspur Park, Raynes Park, Wimbledon

Mondays to Fridays (except bank holidays)

Bicycles cannot join or leave trains that are due to arrive at London Waterloo between 0715 and 1000 or trains which depart from London Waterloo between 1645 and 1900 inclusive.

This means cycles cannot join or leave trains between the following times at our stations:

Motspur Park

last train before morning peak on which bicycles can be carried towards London is 0645

first train after morning peak on which bicycles can be carried towards London is 0945

last train before evening peak on which bicycles can be carried away from London is 1701 (to Guildford)

first train after evening peak on which bicycles can be carried away from London is 1931 (to Dorking)

Raynes Park

last train before morning peak on which bicycles can be carried towards London is 0649

first train after morning peak on which bicycles can be carried towards London is 0942

last train before evening peak on which bicycles can be carried away from London is 1701 (to Shepperton)

first train after evening peak on which bicycles can be carried away from London is 1925 (to Hampton Ct)

Wimbledon

last train before morning peak on which bicycles can be carried towards London is 0653

first train after morning peak on which bicycles can be carried towards London is 0946

last train before evening peak on which bicycles can be carried away from London is 1658 (to Shepperton)

first train after evening peak on which bicycles can be carried away from London is 1919 (to Guildford)

Saturdays and Sundays and bank holidays
