The Lib Dem plan for Stevenage

Better parking

Lib Dems would review excessive car parking charges and offer short free periods, put funds back into local residents' parking schemes. We believe that local councillors, in consultation with residents, should decide which roads need more residents' parking.

Better services

We would allow local councillors, in consultation with residents, to make

decisions on some of the Council's services.

Better environment

Lib Dem councillors help maintain the local environment. We want to see many more electric vehicle charging points in the town. We would plant more trees in the town. We oppose the expansion of Luton airport because of the increased noise and environmental pollution.

Better housing

Lib Dems would ensure high-quality affordable housing with adequate parking and green spaces in suitable locations.

Better planning

Lib Dems would consult more widely on planning applications: instead of just the house next door, include those who live opposite or overlook a new development.

Better health & well-being
