Do you want to shut it out and go on, living your life and taking care of your family in peace?

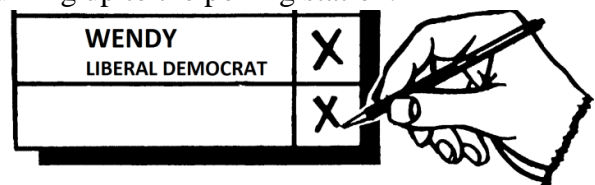
Here's the problem. While some people stay at home on election day, others show up and vote.

The others vote in every election because they know the impact that their vote can have on their lives.

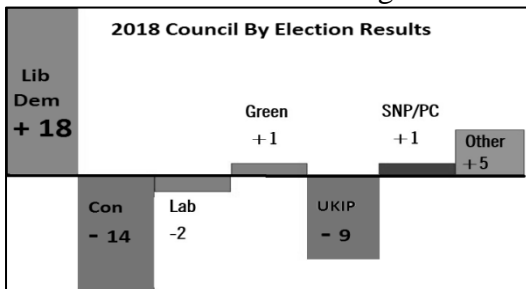
If YOU don't vote you are letting other people make key decisions on the life YOU are going to live. You may not like the consequences of other people's decisions, but that is what happens if you stay at home.

A Better Way to Budget

North Somerset Liberal Democrats alternative budget proposals propose additional investment in key services neglected by the Conservative administration. They include:

- More support for the homeless including prevention
- Public transport subsidies
- Cycling / pedestrian improvements
- Green action fund
- Park and ride feasibility study, for the airport and Weston
- Reductions in parking charges in the towns

This would be paid for by savings including

- Reductions to consultancy fees
- Reductions to councillors allowances
- Green waste collection charge £25 pa

Cllr Mike Bell, Leader of the Liberal Democrat Group said: "After 12 years in charge of North Somerset, the Conservatives are holding our community back. They've stopped listening to local concerns and ignored sensible alternative ideas from opposition groups.

"The Lib Dem Alternative Budget is a chance to invest in key neglected services while keeping the Council Tax rise below inflation. Our fully-costed plans invest in vital services that the Conservatives have ignored: plans for fairer parking, tackling homelessness and backing our community groups trying to make North Somerset cleaner & greener.

"This Alternative Budget shows that a better North Somerset is possible. If Councillors won't vote for this Lib Dem plan, then local people will know that the only way to secure it is for North Somerset to vote Lib Dem in May's elections."
