

COMPETENT PLANNING NEEDED

- Resist additional housing sites being added in Cranleigh during the local plan review
- Support development at Dunsfold to avoid even more houses built in Cranleigh
- Ensure the planned 40% Affordable Housing Rule stays as the local plan develops

ADDRESSING INFRASTRUCTURE AND TRAFFIC

Cranleigh will see the building of many new houses in the near future, regardless of the final detail of Waverley's Local Development Plan, and the infrastructure of the Village (roads, drains etc.) will need to be improved. There will be fierce competition for the funds that will become available from housing developments - keep up the pressure to direct those funds to where they are most needed.



MAINTAINING AND IMPROVING CARE OF THE ELDERLY

The Surrey CC decision to close down care homes across the county is wrong. Maintain and improve the present level of care for the elderly in Waverley. Campaign for Waverley to plan for Extra Care housing to support our growing elderly population and relieve pressure on the NHS.

IMPROVING SMALL BUSINESS SUPPORT

Campaign against rights which allow easy conversion of offices to housing. Ensure there is space and support for local small & young start-up businesses
