



LibDems call for interim Brexit deal

Nick Clegg, the Liberal Democrat's European Union spokesman, is calling for the British government to seek an interim deal based on Norway's status in the Union, while the final terms of the UK's exit from the European Union are being negotiated.

"Without an interim arrangement, the UK's exports to the EU would be subject to the World Trade Organisation terms. Those specify average tariffs of 2 per cent on non-agricultural products, but over 20 per cent on agricultural products" Nick Clegg said, "This would increase our food prices". This position has been supported by Lord Kerr, Britain's most experienced EU negotiator.

The Liberal Democrats believe that the UK should remain within the Single Market after leaving the European Union. Furthermore, the British people should have their say in a referendum on the final Brexit deal. Nick Clegg said "Voting for a departure is not the same as voting for a destination. British people have a right to have their say on whether the deal they are offered is the right one for their families, their communities and our country". This vote could be in several years' time, particularly if there is an interim arrangement while terms are agreed.

LibDems win Richmond Park by-election

Liberal Democrat support is growing across the country as they show they are the only party standing up against a hard Brexit and for a properly funded NHS.

Now the surge has reached new levels with LibDems overturning a huge 23,000 vote majority to take the Conservative stronghold of Richmond Park.
