

## **CONSTITUTION – Adapted for BC Societies Act Transition- Filed November 29, 2016**

**Name** 1. The name of the Society is LEADERSHIP VICTORIA (the "Society").

**Purposes** 2. The purposes of the Society are:

- (a) to develop, support and celebrate leaders who are passionately engaged in building a vibrant community.
- (b) to teach leadership skills in a community learning environment such that program participants realize their leadership potential for the benefit of themselves and the Capital Regional District community generally; and
- (c) to create and sustain a teaching and learning environment consisting of formal education, practical community-based projects, and program-related mentoring.
- (d) to operate as a charitable institution with no member deriving personal financial gain or profit from association with the Society.

In support of the above purposes, the Society may:

- (e) encourage and recognize the donations and bequests to the Society of real or personal property, services or monies and honour reasonable request of donors to the greatest extent practicable;
- (f) disburse the real or personal property or monies of the Society in accordance with the above charitable purposes;
- (g) invest any monies of the Society which are not to be immediately disbursed.
