- Governance/decision-making in co-design: people have a right to say no, this isn't working. Facilitators need to listen and take aligned action.

- You need to consider the broader impact on communities. For example, how might the work impact someone sitting in remote/ regional areas?
- The process should empower the community.
- · Make community the lead and have a tangible outcome.
- Genuine consultation via community consultation and focus groups.
