I am a community transformer, a problem solver, a prize-winning model, a trainer, a manager, a mental health advocate, events organiser, international consultant, cook, support worker, and social impactor. I am a regular speaker at international events, including the recent UN General Assembly 76 Science Summit.

I have created many community projects in Africa, and in the UK. I work by talking to as many people as I can, to identify problems I can help to solve, and the people that can help to solve them.

I was honoured to be elected as the London Regional Diversity Champion, a role I am enjoying greatly and have performed with considerable success, increasing participation and engagement among inclusion and diversity teams as well as leading the development of a diversity strategy.

In 2020 I founded the BLAC (Black Lives Action Committee) Liberal Democrats whose aim is to promote the voice of Black members within the Party. The group now has several hundred members and has developed a wide-ranging policy document, as well as guides for white allies, and on microaggressions.

I believe that making the Party relevant to the UK's diverse voters will be key to any Liberal Democrats success and will unlock our future. I will ensure that the makeup of our Party reflects the diversity of the communities we serve.

We have a series of reports, Alderdice, Thornhill and Diversity Matter being the most recent, that have highlighted the need for action on ethnic minorities for the Liberal Democrats. Action in presenting a compelling policy platform to ethnic minority voters but also action in nurturing party members from diverse communities so that they can become MPs, local councillors, party officers, serving their communities. Members from diverse communities should feel at home, and secure, in the Liberal Democrats.
