## my priorities

### ■ ■ ■ Increase Influence

- Work closely with Regional Chairs to advertise and organise for Regional Conferences;
- Push for Regional Conferences to be included in the Conference Access Scheme;
- Increase the number of Young Liberals elected as English Council delegates;
- Aim to have at least three YL members elected to the English Council Executive in the 2021 ECE elections;
- Protect the money we get from the English Party, by ensuring that reports to English Council Executive highlight its impact and benefit to YL and the wider party.

### ■ ■ ■ Greater Visibility

- Increase and improve social media output, to supplement the federal account;
- Increase communication with a bi-monthly email newsletter - which includes minutes from Exec meetings, and success stories from branches and young elected officials ;
- Create a Twitter list of regional parties and accredited branches;
- Improve the English section of the website - including links to regional party constitutions;
- Add an addendum to the style guide for English Party only material (for example, the logo).

### ■ ■ ■ Champion Diversity

- Invite the Accessibility, Diversity and Standards Officer and the BAME Officer to every EYL Executive meeting;
- Work with Regional Chairs to increase the number of underrepresented voices in Regional Executives;
- Seek balance in English appointments to Federal committees, where possible within the makeup of the Executive;
- Use HQ's diversity calendar to ensure there is an appropriate and timely tweet from the EYL account on all faith, cultural, liberation and memorial days.

### ■ ■ ■ Housekeeping

- Allow people to register interest in becoming substitute English Council delegates; ensuring there is a go-to list in order to field a full slate at every EC meeting;
- Have a friendly competition between Regional Chairs for who can set-up the most new branches and have the most action days for the 2021 local elections;
- Continue to invite one member of the Federal YL Exec to each EYL Executive to brief Regional Chairs about their work.
