Why are you sitting here today listening to this presentation?

You understand the problems we are facing in this country.

1. We have an out of control Federal government and politicians who refuse to adhere to the Constitution.
2. Political parties and the machines that fund establishment candidates are beyond repair and unwilling to support principled candidates.
3. Many nationwide organizations are not focused on the real solutions and mired in unproductive actions that take away from the message and cause people to feel that there is no solution.

The good news is that you also know that there has been a revolution brewing in this country for years. The frustration is that the massive amount of manpower and resources has not been able to be harnessed effectively.

WE PLAN TO CHANGE THAT.

What is the LCRC?

Florida Liberty Candidate Resource Center, LLC can be best described as a company that offers a plan and the products and services that are crucial to the success of the plan.

LibertyTakeover2012 is the name of our plan

Our plan is to restore honest representation to the state of Florida. Our goal is to replace politicians with principled citizen legislators and set up a liberty structure throughout the state based on principle and not a political party.

1. Find and train candidates for political office
2. Find and train precinct organizers across the State of Florida
3. Find and train campaign staff to help candidates win elections

How large is the potential support?

There is already over 20 people per precinct who understand the message of liberty and have been willing to vote their principles.

As of February 2012 there are 11,292,115 voters in the state of Florida.

In the most recent Republican presidential primary there were 118,656 people who voted for either Ron Paul or Gary Johnson.

There were 17,222 registered Libertarians in the State of Florida who did not switch over to vote in the Republican primary.

There are 6,697 precincts in Florida

If we were able to get 25% of those citizens involved we would have 5 people per precinct working directly with the Florida Liberty Candidate Resource Center. This is something that no organization or political party can match.

Why the time is right for a Liberty Takeover in Florida

Americans know something is wrong with this country

The Congressional approval rating as of March 2012 is at 12% with 82% disapproving of the job of their representatives

As of March 2012 only 25% of Americans are satisfied of the direction of this country is headed

The national underemployment rate is at 19.1% as of Feb 2012

The problem is that many are so disenfranchised that they quit voting

Only 75% of the registered voters went to the polls in 2008

Only 45% of the registered voters went to the polls in 2010

Only 41% of the registered Republicans voted in the 2012 presidential primary (1.6 million)

This means that most citizens know something is wrong, many are feeling it everyday and do not think that there is any alternative.

What they are really looking for is some of their neighbors taking the time to inform them about elections and how we can make it easier for them to vote and how that vote will make a difference.

They are looking for principled advice and not political party operatives.

THIS IS WHERE YOU COME IN.

Why we are a for-profit business

PAC's can endorse candidates, offer volunteer training, also, candidate training and indirectly support candidates through independent expenditures.

What PAC's cannot do is legally coordinate PAC activities with the campaigns/ candidates. They cannot communicate in any fashion.

Because we are a campaign consulting business we are able to provide day-to-day campaign organization that grassroots citizen liberty candidates never had access to in the past. Alex and Cico can tell you about that. Candidates that want to advocate liberty and not "special interest" typically do not have access to professional campaign consulting and the critical organized structure needed to be competitive against the special interest, establishment candidates. A non-profit legally can conduct candidate training, although legally, it must be open to any candidate, pro-liberty or not. We are a professional consulting business and we can legally exclude training any candidate that does not promote liberty. Also once a non-profit conducts a candidate training school, they cannot communicate with them after that training. Our training will be on-going day to day.

Bottom Line: Non-profit liberty political groups are great and serve a needed component to electing liberty candidates, so we are not competing against them, actually we are filling the other piece of the puzzle that did not exist before.

How will the LCRC be structured?

The LCRC will be structured from the ground up. It starts with the understanding that each of us are ultimately responsible for our individual precinct. We will have a precinct coordinator in each precinct in the state of Florida. This is the bedrock of the LCRC and the main reason this organization is not easily co-opted.

The next step in the structure is the county coordinator and county candidate recruiter. These two positions are ultimately information hubs for the precinct coordinators in the county. The county coordinator will be responsible for finding precinct coordinators and give them the tools they will need. The candidate recruiters will be responsible to know all the elected positions in each county and let potential candidates know when they will be up for election.

There is also a statewide group that will be responsible for training individuals on various duties of campaigns and becoming a candidate.

We have a 25 person vetting committee that looks at each candidate and makes a determination if the LCRC will support them.

Since this is a For Profit business offering services to candidates and volunteers there will be a paid staff there to help and assist the massive network of volunteers and members.

How can you help us restore liberty in Florida?

- 1. Sign up to join the LCRC network:** It starts with you. Being here shows that you support liberty and Constitutional principles. Fill out the LCRC registration form. We will keep you informed of the county precinct effort and local events within your community.
- 2. Become a Precinct Coordinator:** The backbone of the LCRC is individuals stepping up to take responsibility for promoting liberty and finding like minded individuals in their own precinct.
- 3. Become a member:** By becoming a member you will be directly providing the tools, resources and materials needed to inform the voters on the political process, liberty issues and how they can make an impact.
- 4. Become a candidate or work on a campaign:** The LCRC is offering classes on becoming a candidate or on various campaign positions. If you are interested in getting more involved in campaigns then we can help you.
