

Ms. Bridgett Henson to Receive 2015 Terri Schiavo Life & Hope Award

March 9, 2015 (Life & Hope News Alert) – A devoted mother, Bridgett Henson, fought for the right to make medical choices for her son, Kyle, who had been treated for more than a year at Hahnemann University Hospital in Philadelphia. Kyle, who is 31 and a father of three, has a profound brain injury following complications after a kidney and liver transplant. He remains on a ventilator and a feeding tube.

His mother, who is also his legal guardian, had been fighting for Kyle to be transferred to an Atlanta medical facility closer to their home, so she could better care for him. However, there was repeated delays, despite his guardian's wishes. Just this month, after the intervention of the Terri Schiavo Life & Hope Network, the hospital finally transferred Kyle to a medical facility outside Atlanta.
