4 STOREYS UP SURPASSES EXPECTATIONS — RAISES OVER \$9,700!

Thank you to all the members of the Linden community who came together on May 14th to raise funds for our unique independent school. Due to the incredible response from families and friends, we raised \$9,740 – more than double our \$4,000 goal!

4 Storeys Up featured a live art clash, a silent auction, a giving tree, and a gift card grab. Guests mingled on the roof and enjoyed a delicious meal from Chef Selwyn Richards and The Art of Catering. Six artists, including alumnae and a parent, donated their time and talent to entertain us with a live art clash, then offered their works as part of the silent auction. Several teachers and staff graciously offered Linden experiences, and the younger grades created one-of-a kind crafts for auction.

card grab was a popular
activity. We'd asked each
family to consider donating a gift
card worth at least \$10. What an
amazing response: we collected
86 cards ranging in value
from \$10 to \$50!

to the Grade 9s, who had
a participation rate of 63%,
and the Grade 12s, whose gift card
donations had the highest face
value (\$400)! Both grades were
treated to a pizza lunch on
May 27th.
